#### **How Donations Are Spent**

**\$20** provides professional clothing for employment opportunities

**\$65** provides a 31-day bus pass for transportation to a job, training, and critical health appointments

**\$100** sponsors service of a warm meal for 50 of our homeless neighbors

**\$500** provides a two-month supply of diabetes control medication for 25 of our Clinic patients

**\$1,000** sponsors the purchase of identification documents for 20 clients, materials necessary for housing and employment, including birth certificates
